

sun protection policy

The Nursery would like all children to enjoy the sun safely. For us to achieve this, we need the support of parents/carers.

Parents/carers are requested to put sun protection cream on their children prior to attending Nursery.

Parents/carers are requested to provide their child with a sun hat.

If your child is in the Nursery for a full day, please provide the Nursery with some high factor sun protection cream and please ensure that you write your child's name on it. Where possible, please try to use the one application a day cream.

Parents/carers are requested to ensure that their child is suitably dressed. Please do not put your child in a sun top that exposes their shoulders and back, as the Nursery wants to minimize the risk of exposure to direct sunlight.

The Nursery staff will ensure that children are not in the direct sunshine for any length of time.

The Nursery garden is protected by two large sun sails.

The Nursery staff will ensure that drinking water is available at all times.

To protect the Nursery from any allegations, if your child comes to the Nursery with sunburn you will be asked to complete a form.
