Babies/children who wear nappies

Please ensure that you provide enough nappies/wipes to last your child throughout their Nursery day.

If your child requires nappy cream, please ensure that you supply cream that has a clear label stating its purpose.

Make sure that you have signed your child's registration form as this is authorization for the staff to apply cream on your child.

Potty training

It is important for your child's routine that parents/carers and Nursery staff work closely together. When you think that your child is ready for toilet training, please discuss this with your child's Key Person.

Signs to look for:

- Nappy is frequently dry
- Child is able to tell you if they have wet/soiled their nappy
- Child is able to follow simple instructions, for example "can you put your toy in the box"?

These signs do not usually appear until the child reaches the age of 18 months.

In case of little accidents please can parents/carers provide two sets of clean clothes, ensuring that the clothes are clearly labelled with the child's name.
